# Worship Christ – The Risen Lord!

Ask God to help you understand the power and the promise of the Gospel for your own life.

# Respond in Faith

Ultimately, each one of us needs to decide to respond in faith to Jesus Christ. The hope of Easter is only an idea, until you come to Christ personally in faith. The Bible says that if you, "Confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved" (Romans 10:9). Jesus said, "Behold I stand at the door and knock, if anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in" (Revelation 3:20). Have you opened the door of your heart to Jesus Christ? There will never be a better day than today for you to respond in faith to Christ. The grace, promise and power of Christ are being extended to you as we worship and listen to the message of the Gospel today. Respond in faith! Pray. Tell Jesus that you do believe that He is the risen Lord. Open your heart. Invite Him in – as Savior and Lord. Walk forward into a life of ultimate hope through Jesus Christ our Lord.

### Beginning a Relationship with Jesus Christ

The Good News of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is sort of like a present. You only get the full experience if you open it up. So, how can you respond to the message and the Gospel? Romans 10:9 says, "That if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord', and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved." This is how you respond to what Jesus has done. Put your hope and your faith in Him. Commit your life to Him.

### Believe It

The first step is that you believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead. This belief is so important because it allows the power of the Resurrection to touch your life. Call out to Him in prayer. Just believe.

# Say It

The second step is that you need to confess with your mouth in prayer that Jesus is Lord. This means submitting and committing your life to Him. This might sound scary, but Jesus if the one person you can submit to and be totally safe; totally cared for.

### Dive into the Life God has Waiting for You

The best way to learn about Jesus is to read what the Bible says about His earthly ministry and the Gospel of Mark is a great place to start. Get yourself a Bible. Read a chapter a day. Get with a Christian friend or one of the Pastors and talk about Jesus over coffee. We would love to meet with you. The key is to get started. We promise, you will never be the same!
