If you have been around River West Church at all, you've probably noticed that we constantly talk about the Gospel. This is not accidental. We believe that the good news (i.e. Gospel) about Jesus is not only the main message of the Bible but also the most important truth for all of life.

In his first letter to the Corinthians, the Apostle Paul spoke of the Gospel "as of first importance" (1 Cor. 15:3). The Gospel is the first and most important truth of the Christian faith. The Gospel is central. The Gospel is powerful (Rom. 1:16)! If you learn and treasure the truth of the Gospel it will begin to transform every aspect of your life.

The Power of the Gospel in the Life of a Christian

We want the good news of Jesus to become even more influential in your life, because we are convinced that it is not merely the message that begins your Christian journey. A person doesn't move on from the "milk" of the Gospel to the "meat" of deeper truths. Rather, we move on from the "milk" of the Gospel to the "meat" of the Gospel. What does this mean? It means that the Gospel is both simple and profound. It means that a basic understanding of the good news about the life, death and resurrection of Jesus is sufficient for true repentance and saving faith. And it means that an ever increasing understanding and application of the Gospel is essential for continued growth and change in the Christian life. As Paul said it, we are to "receive" the Gospel, "stand" in the Gospel and "hold fast" to the Gospel (1 Cor. 15:1&2).
